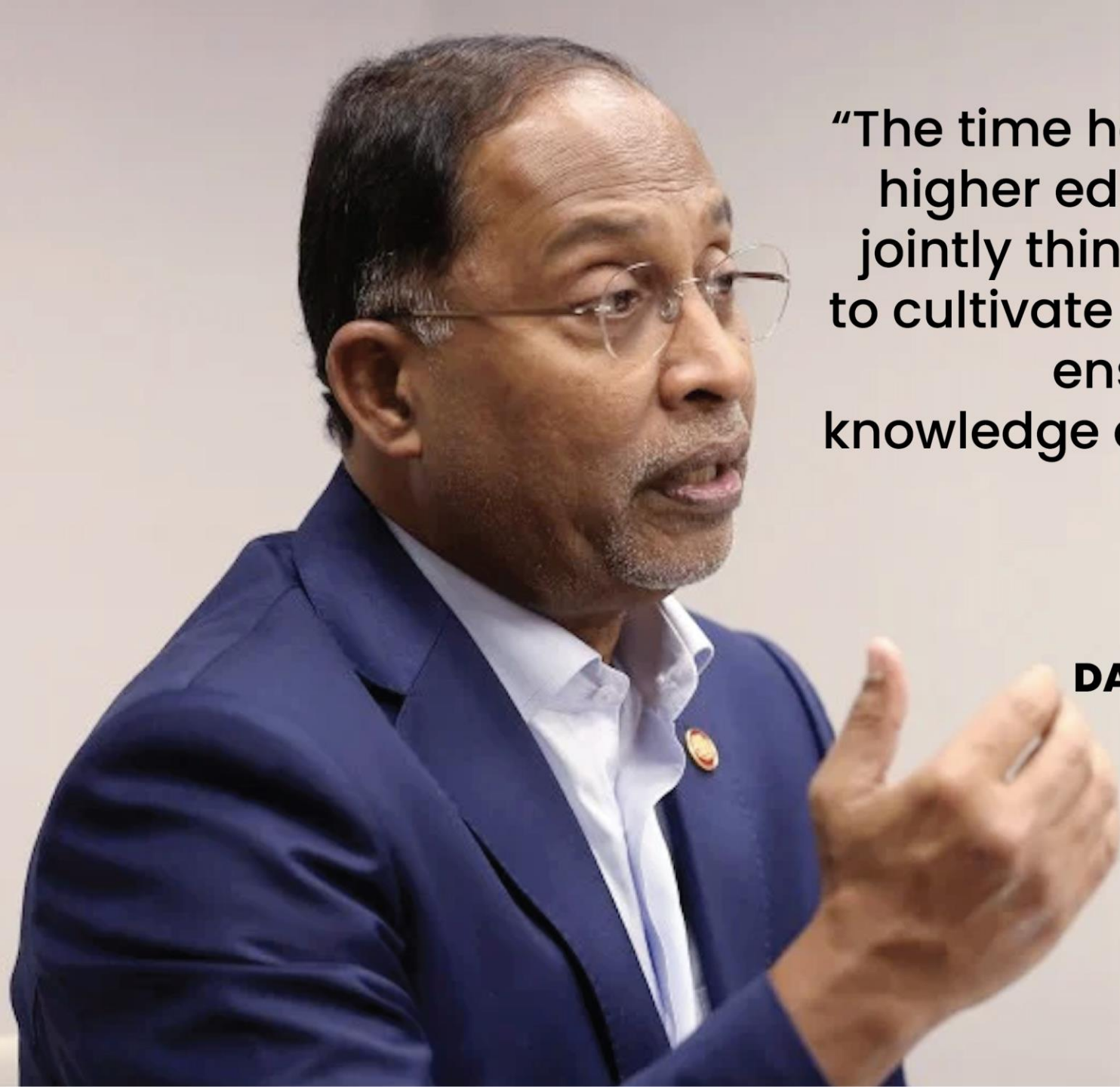

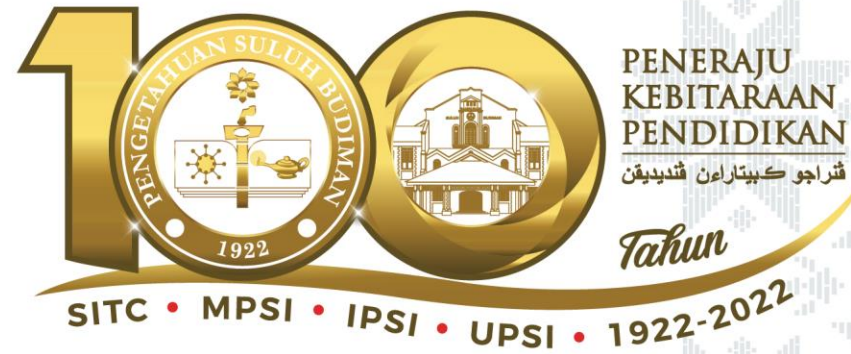

AVANT-GARDE TEACHER AWARD

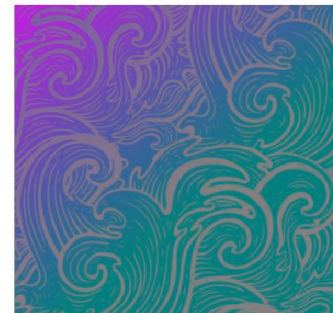

Teacher educators who are in service at any local or international teacher education institutions / universities recognized by state / government authorities. Full or part time teacher educators with a minimum of ten (10) years teaching experience in any discipline are eligible to apply.

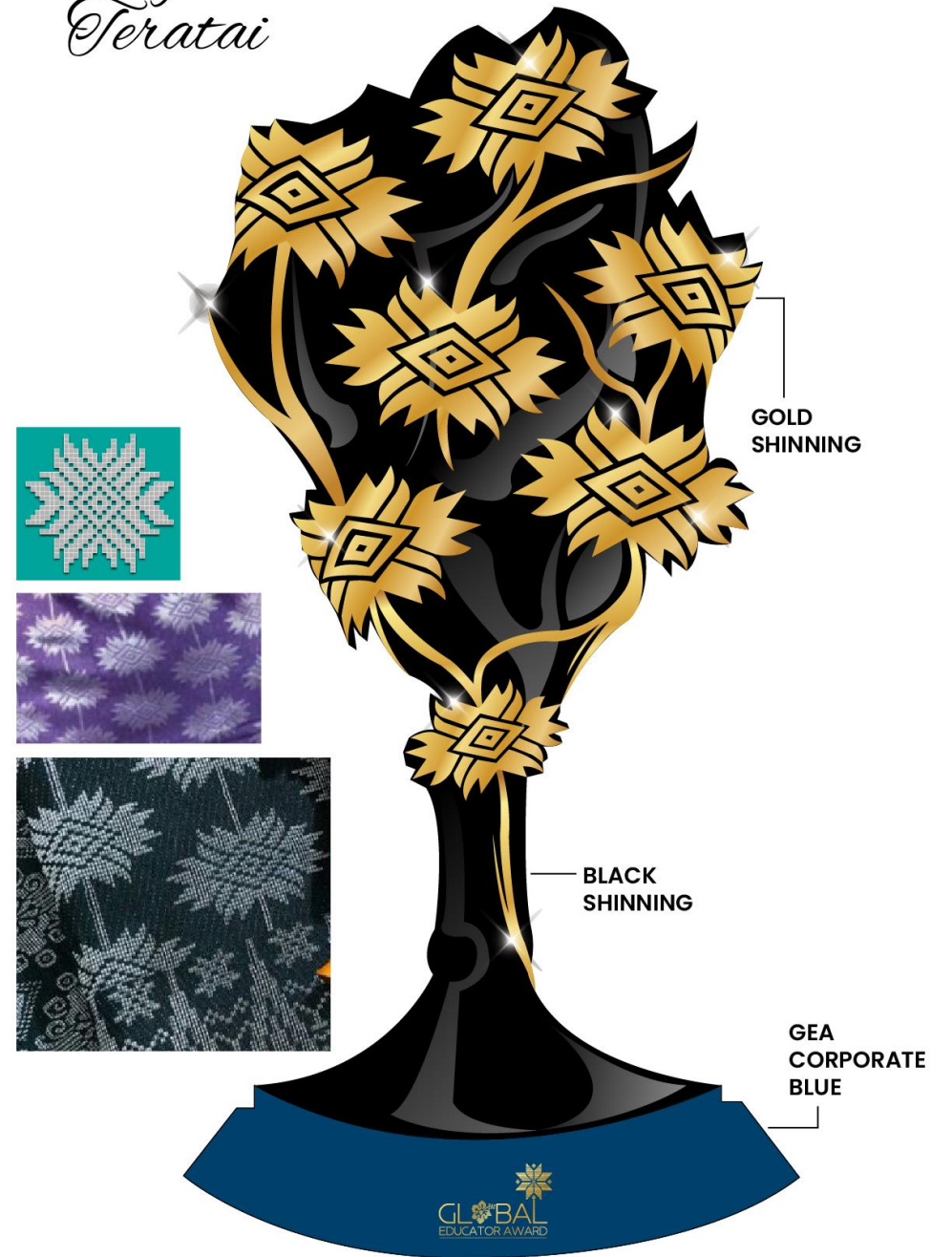

COMMUNITY OUTREACH EDUCATOR AWARD

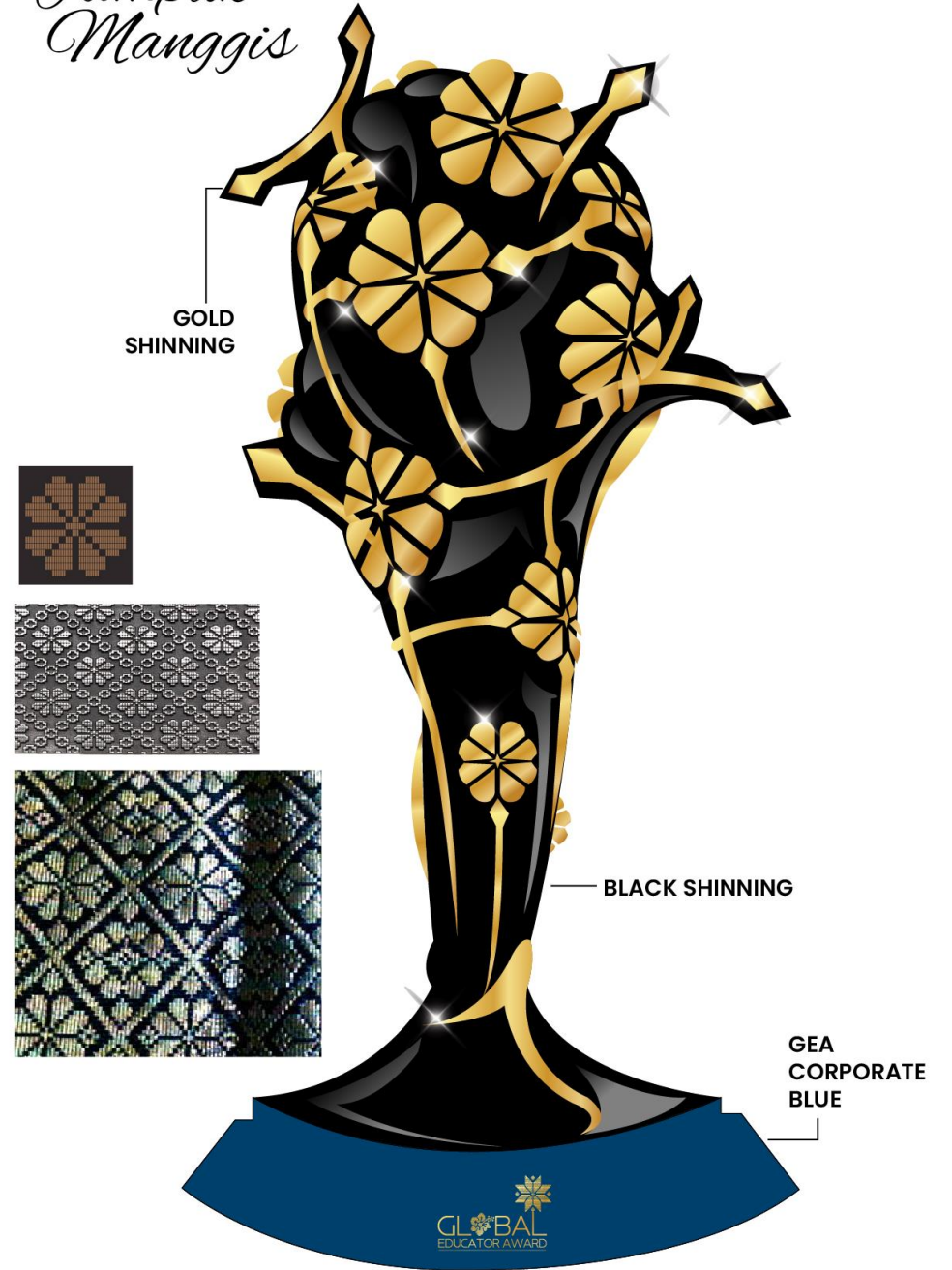
